St Michael's Church has a WWI Memorial Tablet on the north wall which lists the names of those from the village who fell in the Great War, many of whose descendents still live in the area.

As part of the project to restore our peal of five bells it is planned to add a 6th bell, dedicated to those men and commemorating the 100th anniversary of that conflict. To this end, we want to put together a history of each of the men named for inclusion in a commemorative document to be kept in the church.

Much research is therefore needed to gather the information for this project, which is still in its early stages, and we need someone (or possibly more than one!) to undertake this research on our behalf.
